I Cor. 4:17-5:6a

1. For this reason I sent to you Timothy,
my beloved and faithful child in the Lord,
to remind you of *my ways in Christ Jesus*,
as I teach them *everywhere in every church*.

THE TRADITION

2. Some are *arrogant*, as if I were not coming to you.
But I will come to you soon, if the Lord wills,
and I will find out *not the talk* of these arrogant people but their *power*.
For the *kingdom of God* does not consist of *talk* but *power*.

3. What do you want?
Shall I come to you with a *rod*,
or with *love* in a *spirit of gentleness*?

A ROD OR
GENTLENESS?

4. Everyone has reported that there is *immorality among you*,
and of a kind that is not found even among the *gentiles*;
for a man *has* (is living with) *his father's wife*.
And you are *arrogant*!
Ought you not rather to *mourn*?

IMMORALITY AND
ARROGANCE (you)

5. Let him *be removed* from among you,
the one who has done this.
For I, *absent in body*
yet, *present in spirit*,
I have already judged, as present,
the one who has done this.

HIM - REMOVE
BODY
SPIRIT
HIM - JUDGED

6. In the *name* of the *Lord Jesus Christ*.
When *you are assembled*,
and *my spirit is present*,
with the *power* of *our Lord Jesus*,

NAME OF JESUS
YOU - GATHERED
SPIRIT
POWER OF JESUS

7. *surrender* this to *Satan*
for the destruction of the *flesh*,
that his *spirit may be saved*
in the *day of the Lord*.

HIM - REMOVE
FLESH
SPIRIT
DAY OF THE LORD
