**Resurrection:** The Message I Cor. 15:1-11

1. Now I would remind you, brethren, of the gospel I PREACHED which *I preached* to you, which you received, YOU RECEIVED 2. in which you stand, (!) by which you are saved, (!) **BELIEVED** if you hold it fast -(?) IN VAIN? unless you believed in vain. (?) 3. For *I delivered* to you as of first importance AN APOSTLE what I also received. **DELIVERS TRADITION** "Christ died for our sins, 4. in accordance with the scriptures," 5. "he was buried," THE CREED "he was raised on the third day 6. in accordance with the scriptures," "he *appeared* to *Cephas*, 7. then to the twelve." 8. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep. LATER 9. **APPEARANCES** Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles. Last of all, as to one untimely born, he appeared also to me. 10. For I am the *least of the apostles*, LEAST OF unfit to be called an apostle, THE APOSTLES because I persecuted the church of God. 11. But by the *grace of God*, I am what I am, and his grace towards me was not in vain. **GRACE RECEIVED** Rather, I worked harder than any of them, NOT IN VAIN though it was not I, but the grace of God which was in me. 12. Whether then it was I or they, WE PREACHED so we preached and so you believed. YOU BELIEVED

1. And if *Christ is preached* as *raised* from the *dead*,

CHRIST IS RAISED (+)

2. how can some of you say YOUR VIEW:

"There is *no resurrection* of the dead? NO RESURRECTION (-)

3. a. And *if* there is *no resurrection* of the dead,

> b. then *Christ* has *not been raised*: NO RESURRECTION (-)

c. and if Christ has not been raised, NO FAITH

d. then our preaching is empty, NO PREACHING

e. and your faith is empty.

4. We are even found to be *misrepresenting God*, NOT RAISED (-) because we witness of God, OUR WITNESS (+)

he raised the Messiah. OUR WITNESS (+) whom he did not raise NOT RAISED (-)

if it is true that the dead are not raised.

5. a. For if the dead are not raised,

> b. then *Christ* has *not been raised*. NO RESURRECTION (-)

c. And if Christ has not been raised, NO FAITH

d. your faith is futile NO SALVATION

e. and you are still in your sins.

6. Then those asleep in Christ have perished.

If in this life in Christ we have hope only, RESULTS OF we are of *all men most* to be *pitied*. YOUR VIEW (-)

7. But now Christ has been raised from the dead, CHRIST IS RAISED (+) the first fruits of those asleep.

1. For as by a *man* came *death*, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. **ADAM AND** For as in **Adam all die**, **CHRIST** so also in Christ shall all be made alive. 2. But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, **CHRIST-FIRST** then at his *coming* those who *belong to Christ*. THEN THE FAITHFUL 3. Then comes *the end*, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father THE END - ALL after destroying every rule and every authority and power. TO THE FATHER For he must reign until he has put 4. all his enemies under his feet. SON OVER ALL The last enemy to be destroyed is *death*. "For God has put *all things* in subjection **SCRIPTURE** under his feet." (Ps 8:6) But when it says, "All things are put in subjection under him," 5. SON OVER ALL it is plain that *he* is *excepted* who put all things under him. When *all things* are *subjected to him*, 6. then the **Son himself** will also **be subjected** THE END - ALL to *him who* put all things under him, TO THE FATHER that **God** may be everything to every one. 7. Otherwise, what do people mean by being baptized for the sake of the dead? IF DEAD NOT RAISED If the dead are not raised at all, WHY BAPTISM FOR THEIR SAKE? why are people *baptized for their sake*? 9. Why am I in peril every hour? WHY ENDURE? 10. I protest, brethren, by my boasting in you which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I DIE EACH DAY I die every day! 11. What do I gain if, humanly speaking, WHAT REWARD? I fought with beasts at Ephesus? 12. If the dead are not raised, IF DEAD NOT RAISED "Let us *eat* and *drink*, EAT - DRINK, FOR WE DIE!! for tomorrow we die." **ASIDE** Do not be deceived: "Bad company ruins good morals." 13. Come to your right mind, and sin no more. For some have no knowledge of God. I say this to your shame.

THE NATURE OF THE RESURRECTION BODY: Christ and Adam I Cor. 15:35-50

1. But some one will ask,

"How are the dead raised? With what kind of a body do they come?"

HOW ARE THE DEAD RAISED?

2. You foolish man!

What you *sow* does not come to *life* unless it *dies*. And *what you sow* is not the body which is to be, PLANTS but a *bare kernel*, perhaps of wheat or of some other grain.

3. But God gives it a body as he has chosen, and to each kind of seed its own body. For not all flesh is alike, MEN, ANIMALS but there is one kind for men, another for animals, BIRDS, FISH another for birds, and another for fish.

4. There are celestial bodies and there are terrestial bodies; but the *glory of the celestial* is one, and the *glory of the terrestial* is another.

GLORY OF HEAVENLY/EARTHLY

5. There is one glory of the *sun*, and another glory of the *moon*, and another glory of the *stars*; for star differs from star in glory.

GLORY OF HEAVENLY BODIES

6 So it is with the *resurrection of the dead*. What is sown is *perishable*, what is raised is *imperishable*.

SO THE RESURRECTION PERISHABLE IMPERISHABLE

7. It is *sown* in *dishonor*, it is raised in *glory*. It is sown in *weakness*, it is raised in *power*.

WEAKNESS TO GLORY AND POWER

8. It is sown a *physical body*, it is raised a *spiritual body*. If there is a *physical body*, there is also a *spiritual body*.

PHYSICAL SPIRITUAL

Thus it is written,

9. "The *first man* Adam became a *living being*"; I A. REC. LIFE the *last Adam* became a *life-giving spirit*. II A. GIVES LIFE

10. But it is not the *spiritual* which is first but the *physical*, and then the *spiritual*. PHYSICAL The *first man* was from the earth, a man of *dust*; SPIRITUAL the *second* is from *heaven*.

11. As was the man of dust, so are those who are of the dust; and as is the man of heaven, so are those who are of heaven.

Just as we have borne the image of the man of dust, DUST TO we shall also bear the image of the man of heaven. IMAGE OF CHRIST

I tell you this, brethren:

flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, PERISHABLE nor does the *perishable* inherit the *imperishable*. IMPERISHABLE

1.	Lo! I tell you a mystery.  A MYSTERY REV		
2.	We shall <i>not all sleep</i> , but we shall <i>all be changed</i> ,	NOT ALL SLEEP WE - CHANGED	
3.	in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye,	IN A MOMENT	
4.	at the <i>last trumpet</i> . For the <i>trumpet will sound</i> ,	AT THE TRUMPET	
5.	and the <i>dead</i> will be <i>raised imperishable</i> , and we shall be <i>changed</i> .	RAISED WE - CHANGED	
6.	For this <i>perishable</i> nature <i>must put on the</i> imperishable,	<i>PERISHABLE</i> IMPERISHABLE	
7.	and this <i>mortal</i> nature must put on <i>immortality</i> .	MORTAL IMMORTAL	
8.	When the <i>perishable</i> puts on the <i>imperishable</i> ,	PERISHABLE IMPERISHABLE	
9.	and the <i>mortal</i> puts on <i>immortality</i> ,	MORTAL IMMORTAL	
10.	then shall come to pass the saying that is written, "Death is swallowed up in victory."	VICTORY	
11.	"O <i>death</i> , where is thy <i>victory</i> ? O <i>death</i> , where is <i>thy sting</i> ?"	DEATH	
12.	The sting of death is sin and the power of sin is the law.	DEATH	
13.	But <i>thanks</i> be to <i>God</i> who gives us the <i>victory</i> through <i>our Lord Jesus Christ</i> .	VICTORY
